

HOLBECKS CAR TRIAL SUNDAY 5TH FEBRUARY 2012 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. **The West Suffolk Motor Club Limited** will organise a Clubsport Permit Car Trial on **SUNDAY 5TH FEBRUARY 2012** at Holbecks Park, Hadleigh, Suffolk, IP7 5PE – Map Reference 155/025422. The site will be arrowed from the B1070, High Street, Hadleigh.
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit No – To be Advised
4. The event is open to all fully elected and associate members of the organising club and fully elected members of Eastern Counties MC, Chelmsford MC, Cambridge Car Club, Falcon MC, Kings Lynn & District MC and Sporting Car Club of Norfolk.
5. Entries will be accepted from drivers over the age of 14 but any driver, regardless of age, who does not hold a full RTA driving licence must be accompanied, at all times, by an adult who does and who is an experienced trialist. Passengers must be a minimum of 12 years old. Passengers under 17 may only ride with drivers who hold a full RTA licence. Passengers from 2 to 12 years old may ride on the back seat of a saloon car but if under 135cm in height must be seated using an approved “child restraint”
6. All drivers must produce a valid club membership card.
7. The programme of the meeting will be:

Scrutineering	08.15 am
First Car	09.15 am

Any competitor not signed on by 9.15am may be excluded.
8. Public roads will not be used to link sections; there will be at least 25 sections on private land. The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills.
9. The event will consist of three classes, as follows:

CLASS A	Front wheel drive
CLASS B	Rear engined cars
CLASS C	Open sports and kit cars and those cars excluded from other classes, also cars with LSDs may be subject to handicap.
CLASS D	Newcomers unless driving Class C cars
10. All classes must comply with MSA Technical Regulations except for the following which have been modified:

M5 8 1	Vehicles need not be currently registered or taxed due to the event taking place solely on private land
M7 3 1	Valances and skirts may be removed

M7 4 Engines, Diffs, Carburettors and Gearboxes may be varied from standard but must be from the same model range

M7 7 Wheel and Tyre sizes may be varied from standard. Winter pattern tyres will not be allowed. The organisers reserve the right to alter tyre pressures before and during the event to account for weather conditions and fair competition.

11 Awards will be as follows:

First Overall Treasurers Trophy (to be held for 11 months) plus replica
(lowest marks lost)

First in Class An Award

Second in Class An Award (subject to 5 starters)

N B – First Overall forfeits class award

12 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally on **MONDAY 30TH JANUARY 2012**. The entry fee is £20.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. NO LATE ENTRIES.
